While in the field teachers share their experience with their students through Skype and other online tools, and through the Bush Blitz TeachLive website where they post blogs, share photographs and videos and conduct interactive forums.

You do not have to be experienced or science-trained just passionate about science and fieldwork and then sharing this passion with your students, colleagues and education networks.
